*"The Lord is my light and my salvation ..."* Psalm 27:1

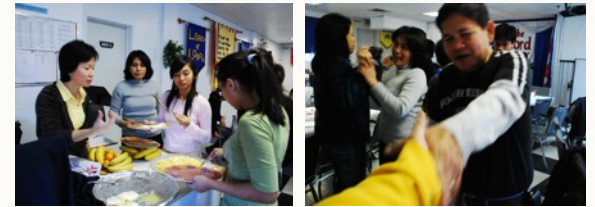
### DEVOTION OF THE WEEK:
